The vita is not to exceed 2 pages in length (i.e., pdf file should not be more than 3 pages total) and should include information concerning the student's: academic performance, scholarly interests/accomplishments, leadership, and service to the profession. **Please name the file as follows using the appropriate university name: *Undergrad Louisiana State.pdf, Undergrad Springfield.pdf, or Undergrad Florida.pdf, etc.***

**Attachment 2:** A digital photo of the student (400 x 600 pixel JPEG preferred). Photo should not be imbedded in a Word docx or pdf file. It must be attached separately.

Any nomination e-mail not in compliance with these guidelines will be rejected.
